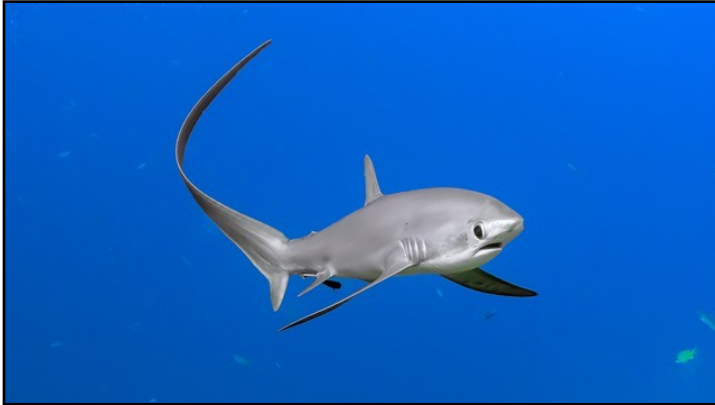

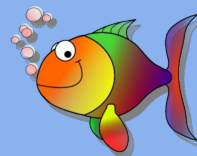

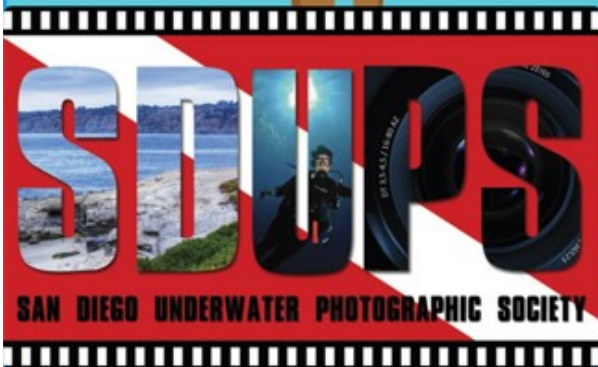


TOM & MAXINE BAKER

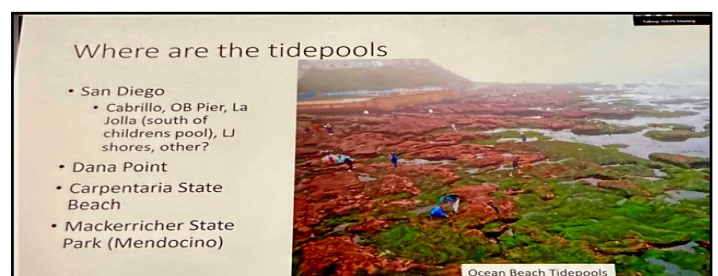

SDUPS Monthly Competition Rules

1. You must be a current member of SDUPS to participate in the monthly competition.

2. You can submit one photo each month in your respective photo division and/or one video in the Video category. All entries follow the same defined competition category for the month. Submit entry via the online Submission Form on the SDUPS website.

3. Entry Deadline - In general, the deadline for competition entries each month precedes the monthly meeting by 2.5 weeks. We will send out an email to members with all of the info, confirming the deadline and other important reminders, about two weeks before the deadline. Voting is done via an online Google Form prior to the monthly meeting. Members and non-members may vote.

4. File Types

Photos - Submit .jpg files with resolution pixel count not exceeding 1920 on long end and 1080 on short end.

Videos - Must be submitted in MP4 format in 1920x1080 resolution. All videos must be under 30 seconds. There can be multiple clips within your video. Any video over the 30 second RULE will be disqualified.

5. File Name - Name your file with your class/category (in lower case)_first initial & last name (i.e. adv_mpoirier.jpg) nov=novice, ama=amateur, adv=advanced; vid=category for all videos.

6. Photo Division is determined by accumulated points. Advancement between divisions is announced at the SDUPS Awards Banquet, or its equivalent.

- a. Novice: 25 points or less
- b. Amateur: 26 to 70 points
- c. Advanced: 71 points or more

7. New members may choose which division, Novice, Amateur, or Advanced, when first joining. After that time, you will compete in that division moving forward and cannot request a change.

8. Competition Points are awarded for placement in the competition. In case of a tie, all tying entries will be awarded the corresponding point value of their placement.

- a. 1st - 5 points
- b. 2nd - 3 points
- c. 3rd - 1 point

9. Footage Modification:

a. Allowed: Cropping, Sharpening, Removal of noise/backscatter, Color Adjustments (Levels, Hues, Color Balance, Dodge & Burn, etc.)

b. Not Allowed: Alterations of image content, removal or addition of subjects or material. For example, removal/adding a diver, fish, etc.

10. Reuse of prior entries – To encourage creativity with entries, a photo or video that has placed 1st 3rd in any category may not be used again for three years. **A color/greyscale conversion is considered the same photo for the purposes of this rule.

11. Adopted Environmental Awareness Guidelines:

Marine life should never be stressed or endangered for the sake of a photo. Entries in our monthly competitions exhibiting the following behavior will be disqualified:

- a. Diver visibly damaging (i.e. gear dragging into) the environment.
- b. Animals with signs of diver induced stress (i.e. puffed puffers, inking octopus).
- c. Animals moved to an unnatural environment or risky location.
- d. Animals being fed artificial food from divers (i.e. chum visible in photograph).
- e. Marine life being harassed (i.e. touching corals, seahorse tails).

12. Photographer and Videographer of the Year recognition and corresponding award shall be given to the member in each division who earns the most competition points during that calendar year. This recognition and corresponding award will be given during the SDUPS Awards Banquet, or its equivalent.

13. Competition Winner Results/Records - Each month the competition committee will provide results to the Secretary/Historian to keep an accurate record of all members' current point status, and is available for any questions arising on this topic. Current competition results and process documents are saved on the SDUPS Google Drive and/or club computer and are available to audit.

14. Participation Points – each competition entry earns one participation point. You can earn an additional participation point per entry if the defined Bonus Challenge criteria is met. Participation points are used for the end of year prize raffle and are separate from the category winner competition points.

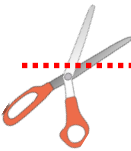

Sumner Auditorium Parking Map

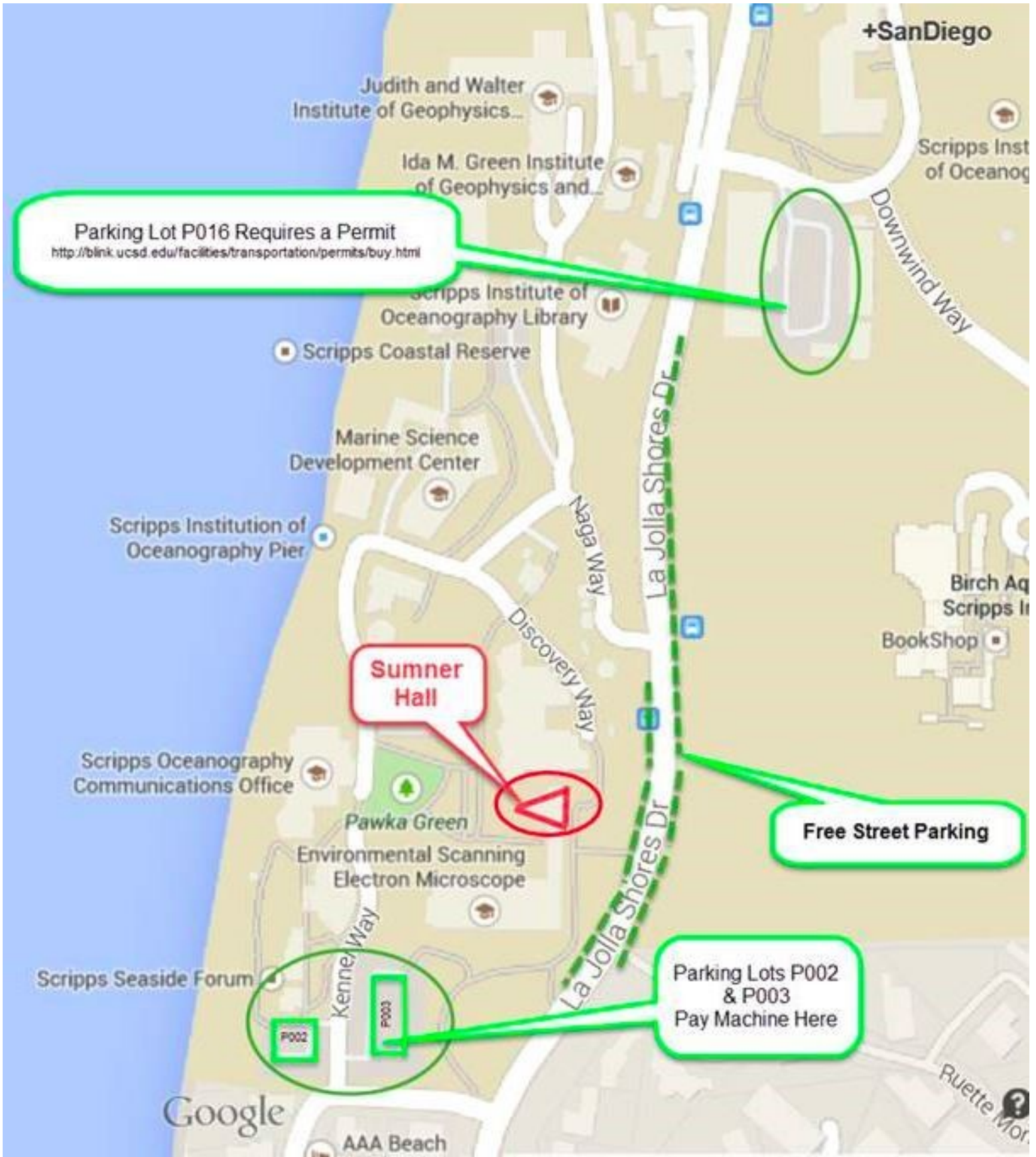
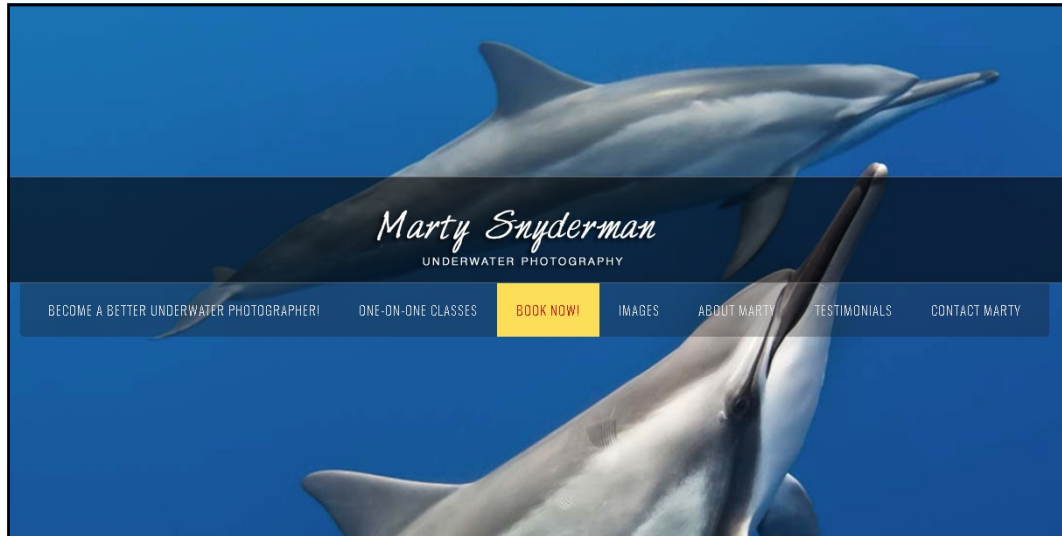


Photo Classes

One-on-one online classes in underwater photography with **Marty Snyderman** Classes are scheduled at your convenience and customized to match your goals 20% of the class fees are donated to SDUPS



BECOME A BETTER UNDERWATER PHOTOGRAPHER! Underwater photography is a learned skill. So, you might as well learn from the best, an excellent photographer that is also an excellent teacher. Your instructor, Marty Snyderman, is that person.

When taking classes from Marty, you will receive one-on-one instruction as you review your images, discuss ways to improve your underwater photography, refine the techniques you are using, and learn new techniques, concepts, and skills that will help you create the photographs you want to make. The sessions center around techniques and are not tied to any particular make, model, or type of camera or camera system that can be used to make still photographs underwater.

Sharing a session with Marty is also a great way to re-fresh your photography skills before your next diving vacation. If you only get to dive a few times a year, during your next trip you are likely to spend a few days relearning and refreshing your skills. A session or two with Marty before your trip can turn the frustration and lost time from having to relearn into fun dives and pleasing photographs.

How It All Works The one-on-one program is completely customizable to your knowledge, skill level, and personal goals. Marty will use Zoom software to work with you. He has licensed a version of the software that enables the two of you to keep the sessions private.

During each session, Marty will share his expertise and help you gain a better understanding of various factors involved in underwater photography, and he will suggest techniques for you to employ that can help you improve your underwater photography. Each session can be up to 60 minutes long. The cost for a session is \$65.00 U.S. Any additional time that you will not be charged for is provided at Marty's discretion or through the purchase of another session.

Competition Themes For 2026

Month	Topic Name	Description	Bonus
January	Best of 2025	Select your favorite underwater footage from 2025	Tell why you chose this entry (use note field in submission form)
February	Popping Up/Out	In honor of Groundhog Day, composition with subject(s) popping up/out of a hole or from behind a barrier	More than one subject together
March	Behavior - Different Species	Composition that shows different species interacting in same way	Shows a symbiotic relationship (a close & recurring interaction, beneficial)
April	New Beginnings	Showcase eggs, newborns, or juveniles	Vertebrate subject(s) - fish, reptile, bird, mammal)
May	Attention to Detail	Examples include tiny subjects, close-ups of large subjects or other artistic intention that emphasizes details	Repeating pattern/texture
June	Sea Slugs	Any marine gastropod without a shell - Nudibranchs, Sear Hares, Sapsuckers, Headshield Slug, etc.	Provide the common or scientific name (use note field in submission form)
July	Big, Bright & Sunny	Wide angle Composition with prominent	Ambient light only
August	Shooting the Surface	Subject is on the surface (boat, swimmer, bird, etc.) footage shot from your perspective. Over/under, silhouettes, or	Sky is visible
September	Leafy	Animals resembling vegetation (such as sponges, tunicates, anemones, pipefish, seahorses, sea dragons)	Autumn colors -strong use of red, orange, and/or yellow
October	Spooky	Open to your interpretation. Examples: "dark & stormy", compositions or a scene that is scary for other reasons.	Shows something not alive (dead animal remains or inanimate objects such as wrecks)
November	Photoshopped	Creative editing/manipulation using digital programs such as PhotoShop. No restrictions. "Your entry must include your underwater work somewhere in the composition, Anything else used must be royalty/copyright free.	Add a title (use note field in submission form) Can be creative or humorous

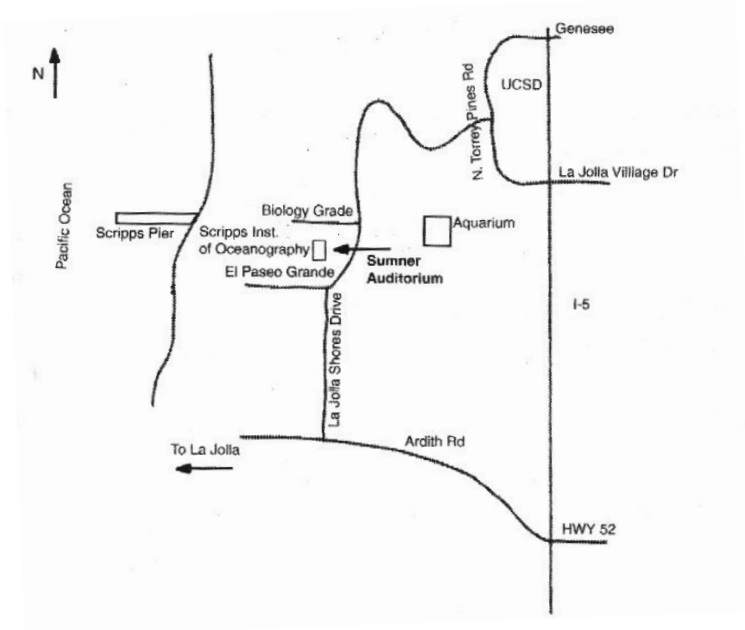
